EVAAS: What's New in 2023

Redesign of Student Reports

Student reports have been updated with additional content, a fresh new look, and a user-friendly interface. These redesigned Student reports include student testing history, projections, and demographics all on one page. The Student report desk reference in the EVAAS online Help provides detailed information about this redesigned report and how to navigate new click paths.

District and School Value-Added Updates

The 2022-23 reporting enables users to compare up to 10 districts or schools on the District and School Value-Added report. Users also have the option to download their district and school value-added data directly from this report.

New Report: Growth of Student Groups

Growth of Student Groups, a new report in EVAAS, provides district and school value-added measures for specific student groups. You can view the report by student group or by subject area for a district or school. This report provides similar insights to the District and School Value-Added reports, but the results are specifically for the applicable group of students.

New District and School Diagnostic Report Colors

The 2022-23 reporting includes new District and School Diagnostic report colors when growth is selected as a measurement option. These new Diagnostic colors appear in the table under the graph and are outlined below:

- Dark Green indicates moderate evidence that the group exceeded the expected growth.
- Medium Green indicates evidence that the group met the expected growth.
- Light Green indicates moderate evidence that the group did not meet the expected growth.

Value-Added Composite Updates

The 2022-23 reporting includes a current year composite and an up-to-two-year composite for District and School Accountability Value-Added reports.

The 2022-23 reporting includes up-to-two single-year composites for Teacher Value-Added reports.

Removal of the Decision Dashboard

The Decision Dashboard has been removed from the EVAAS website. We recommend reviewing the Diagnostic reports, which provide similar insights to those provided by the Decision Dashboard along with added functionality.

Grade 4 Projections

The 2022-23 reporting will include student projections to Grade 4 subjects. These projections will be available on the Student Projection, the Student Projection Summary, and the Student Success Summary reports.
